

Trelissick Park Group 30th Birthday Family Picnic

Where: Wightwick's Field, Trelissick Park

When: Sunday 21 November, 12 noon to 2:00pm

Access: Entrance #2 on Waikowhai Street. Take the track down to Wightwick's Field. Follow the balloons.

Parking: Crofton Downs Railway Station, lower carpark

BYO: Picnic food and refreshments, rugs, blankets, folding chairs, sunblock, rubbish bags etc. If you can, bring soccer balls, pole tennis, volleyball nets etc for the children and young people.

Toilets: There are no toilet facilities in the Park. Go before you come!

Rubbish: We all love the natural environment of the Park. Please remove your own rubbish when you leave.

Supervision of children: Wightwick's Field is situated beside the Korimako Stream, and is surrounded by native bush. It is your responsibility to supervise your children at all times.

HQ: TPG volunteers will be at the bench seat near the stream.

Covid 19: Please observe the rules for whatever Level we are on the day. Hand sanitiser will be available at the HQ bench seat.

First Aid: A First Aid kit will be available at the HQ bench seat for minor mishaps. If you are a medic, please let HQ know when you arrive so that we know that we can call on you if there is a more serious incident.

Postponement: If the weather is inclement, the picnic will be postponed to the following Sunday, 28 November. Check the TPG Facebook page for postponement information at 9:00am.

We look forward to meeting you and enjoying an informal family picnic with you in our beautiful park.

After the picnic there will be a short, conducted tour of Trelissick Park for those with interest in the historic and botanical aspects of the park.
