

# TRELISSICK PARK - vascular native plant list

## Ngaio Gorge, Wellington

Updated May 2023

**Map:** NZTopo50-BQ31 Wellington, centred on grid reference ca. 483308.

**Location:** Between Ngaio and Wadestown.

**Area:** ca. 24 hectares of native forest (including leased railway land), native plantings and introduced species.

**Geology:** Lithology: B-H: Wellington greywackes: alternating dark-grey argillite and greywacke sandstone, intensely sheared and semi-schistose; Balfour Series, Triassic. *NZ Geological Map 1 : 250,000 Wellington, Sheet 12, 1<sup>st</sup> edition*. 1975.

**Soils:** Pedology: 7: Ngaio-Kaitoke Soils; 10: Korokoro-Makara Soils. *Soils of Wellington District*. H. S. Gibbs, Soil Bureau, D.S.I.R, 1960.

**Catchment:** Kaiwharawhara Stream with Te Mahanga and Korimako Stream tributaries.

**Elevation range of entire catchment:** 445 m (Mt Kaukau) – sea level at Kaiwharawhara Point, Wellington Harbour – Te Whanganui a Tara.

**Landform:** steep-sided valley with a series of spurs and intervening gullies with tributary streams.

**Ecological District:** Wellington Ecological District 39.01.

**Rainfall:** 1228.9 mm p.a. (gauge at Kelburn Meteorological Office).

**Aspect:** true left side of Kaiwharawhara Stream: southwest-south-southeast; true right side of Kaiwharawhara Stream: northeast-north-northwest.

**Forest classification:** Some remnant pre-European forest; regenerating, semi-coastal, podocarp-broadleaf forest; with mixed indigenous-advective shrublands, native plantings and weeds.

**Tenure:** Wellington City Council.

**Status:** Scenic Reserve under the Reserves Act 1977.

**Central government:** Department of Conservation, Kāpiti-Wellington Area Office.

**Regional authority:** Greater Wellington Regional Council.

**Names:** <sup>1</sup> 'Kai' = food; 'wharawhara' - *Astelia banksii* = coastal astelia.
